We all share the pride of membership as Scottish Rite Masons and treasure the bond of fellowship with our Brothers. Some of us are Past Masters and have also become Shrine Nobles as well. That's why I have commissioned three new fraternal rings for our Brothers, which are highly personalized with the Scottish Rite Double-Headed Eagle, and options to add a Shrine Scimitar & Crescent or Past Master's Jewel to further distinguish each ring.

These unique rings for our great fraternity have features found in rings costing far more, and are available in a variety of precious metals and diamond options to be affordable for all Brothers:

- The top of each ring bears a finely sculpted Scottish Rite Eagle, cast in solid 10 Karat Gold and mounted on a genuine black onyx stone. The words Scottish Rite Mason, sculpted in high-relief letters, surround the Eagle.
- You may choose to have the body of your ring cast in solid 10 karat Gold or Sterling Silver finished in antiqued gold. And, you may also choose to personalize your ring with a genuine .10 carat diamond set within the chest of the Eagle. The effect of solid gold and a brilliant diamond, featured against a rich, reflective black jeweler's stone is stunning.
- The sides of the ring are beautiful original sculptures featuring a Masonic Square and Compasses and letter "G" on one side and a highly detailed 14° Perfect Elu, representing our pursuits of character, tolerance and personal conviction, on the other side.
- If you are a Shrine Noble or a Past Master you may choose to have the Shrine Scimitar & Crescent or Past Master Jewel on the side of your ring, in place of the 14° Perfect Elu.
- As a final touch of exclusivity your ring will be engraved on the inside band with your initials and unique serial number.
